Seize the opportunity to be part of a world-class mega event and enjoy exposure to international green building experts in the coming June!

Introduction

Green Ambassador Pitch is a brand new programme under Hong Kong Green Building Week 2017, an annual territory-wide public campaign co-organised by the Construction Industry Council (CIC) and the Hong Kong Green Building Council (HKGBC).

This speaking contest aims to encourage students to be climate ready and influence the people around them to act on climate change. The pitching day will be staged during the pre-eminent global green building conference World Sustainable Built Environment Conference 2017 Hong Kong (WSBE17 Hong Kong) at Hong Kong Exhibition and Convention Centre in June 2017. Teams will enjoy the golden opportunity to express their thoughts and ideas in front of renowned judges and international delegates. To assist with the preparation, participating teams will be assigned a green building professional mentor and go through trainings on green building knowledge, community green works and public speaking skills.

Green Ambassador Pitch is co-organised by CIC and HKGBC in partnership with Friends of the Earth (HK), Hong Kong Speakers Bureau and The Outstanding Young Persons Association; supported by Junior Achievement Hong Kong.

Winner Selection and Awards

The best performing team will receive the "Best Presentation Award". There will be two parts of assessments on the pitching day: judging panel and audience voting. The team with the highest combined score will be the winner. The audience is made up of green building professionals from all over the world, and members of the judging panel include:

- Mr Curt Garrigan, Cities and Buildings Programme Officer, United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP)
- Mr Tony Ip, Board Governor, Friends of the Earth (HK)
- Representative(s) from CIC and HKGBC

The winning team and their school will be awarded:

All students will receive a certificate of participation upon completion of the Green Ambassador Pitch programme.

- Applications should be submitted through schools. Each school can submit application for only one student team.
- The maximum number of participating teams is 8-10 teams.
- Participants should attend all trainings and the pitching day. The Organisers may review the eligibility of participants who are absent from any of the activities.
