

Preventive Measures in Response to COVID-19

In view of the latest situation of COVID-19, we would like to reassure all of our Conference participants that the following precautionary measures are adopted to reduce health risks:

1. Temperature screening is available upon entering the hotel. Any visitors with high temperature and/or display respiratory symptoms will be denied entry.
2. Nina Hotel Tsuen Wan West, the Conference venue, has “LeaveHomeSafe” QR code available at the hotel main door and the entrance of the ballroom.
3. Conference venue capacity is strictly controlled to go beyond the necessary protocols required by the authority. Seating is well spaced out and distanced to maintain appropriate social distancing.
4. Venue will be well ventilated and sanitised. Germagic™, a smart coating proven to be effective in killing viruses, bacteria and even hard-to-kill spores, has been applied throughout the venue.
5. Hand sanitisers will be available at the venue.
6. Eating and drinking are strictly prohibited within the venue (i.e. foyer and ballroom), thus no food or drinks will be served during the Conference.
7. To minimise risk, Conference programme is only available online.
8. All participants, speakers, moderators, working staff and contractors are reminded about personal hygiene and the preventive measures prior to the Conference.

In order to ensure a safe conference for everyone, we urge you to pay special attention to and comply with the followings when you attend the Conference:

1. Refrain from joining the Conference if you have:
 - high temperature and / or respiratory symptoms.
 - close contact with confirmed case and / or preliminarily positive case of COVID-19 in the past 7 days prior to the Conference.
 - lived with any person under home quarantine in the past 7 days prior to the Conference.
2. Use the “LeaveHomeSafe” (“LHS”) mobile app to scan the LHS QR code before entering the hotel.
3. Comply with the Prevention and Control of Disease (Vaccine Pass) Regulation (Chapter 599L). Any person with a Red code or an Amber code will be denied entry.
4. Wear surgical mask and practise good hygiene at all times during the Conference.
5. Keep appropriate social distancing in the venue and avoid any close contact and any gatherings of more than 12 people during the Conference and break times.
