# 2 Latest Update

## **BEAM Plus Version 1.2**



HKGBC is pleased to announce that the **BEAM Plus Version 1.2** for New Buildings (NB) and Existing Buildings (EB) is now available for new project registration on HKGBC's website.

The new version of BEAM Plus Version 1.2 for New Buildings (NB) and Existing Buildings (EB) introduced a holistic component of Passive Design as an alternative method for assessment. To add clarity to the assessment and its requirements, minor amendments are also made in BEAM Plus Version 1.2.

From now on till 31 December 2012, project applicants can choose either BEAM Plus Version 1.1 or BEAM Plus Version 1.2 for assessments.

Project applicants which had been registered under BEAM Plus Version 1.1 can notify the HKGBC Secretariat if they wish to switch to Version 1.2, subject to whether a fee for registration is required.
