On Tuesday 24 May, World Green Building Council launched a bold new policy plan for the European Union to accelerate progress on decarbonising buildings and construction, one of the most heavily emitting sectors in the world.

Developed with the support of a coalition of over 35 leading industry bodies through WorldGBC's flagship #BuildingLife project, the EU Policy Roadmap is the first of its kind at EU scale to address the whole life carbon impact of the built environment, across multiple policy routes.

The ongoing war in Ukraine has brought suffering and tragedy on a scale many of us thought, and hoped, not to see in Europe in our lifetimes.


It has also underscored the urgent need to tackle energy security and reduce reliance on fossil fuels on a global scale.

In the wake of the invasion, the EU has published a new energy plan called <u>REPowerEU</u> to move Europe's energy systems towards a more resilient and green future.

However, the role of buildings and infrastructure in addressing the crisis has been largely overlooked.

WorldGBC is calling on the EU to rectify this oversight, by drawing attention to how accelerating building renovation can massively reduce the EU's energy consumption.


